Main Tasks of Moderators (I)

- To deal with the subject matter ("the combination of different funding programmes & creating synergies") entirely.
- To guide the conversation & ensure putting on the track when needed.
- To address the related questions to foster discussions.
- To try highlighting the similarities and differences raised by participants.
 - To put emphasis not only on the agreed issues but also the conflicts.



Main Tasks of Moderators (II)

- To ensure each participant having opportunity to contribute to the debate(s).
 - Allow them to question each other
- To follow and manage the time sharing among different questions/issues.
 - To ensure the each issue discussed 30 minutes.
 - To ensure reserving enough time to reach conclusion(s) for each issue.
- To interact with the rapporteur before discussion
 - To ensure that (s)he will provide adequate notes/concluding-remarks at the end.
 - To ensure that the participants are agreed with your conclusion(s)



Issues to discuss

- 1. Upstream activities (30 minutes)
 - a. How to build up capacities for the excellent research?
- 2. Downstream activities and (30 minutes):
 - **b.** How to better exploit research results?
- 3. Stakeholder involvement: (30 minutes)
 - c. What are the incentives, obstacles and opportunities for policy makers and innovation stakeholders to maximise societal impact of EU R&I funding instruments?



Please define following dimensions for each issue

- Barriers and obstacles against creating synergies.
- Tools and instruments that can facilitate overcoming these barriers and obstacles.
- Three –concrete- policy recommendations addressing the main problems you have addressed.
